Notice Regarding Dividend of Retained Earnings (Dividend Increase) and Dividend Forecast for the next Fiscal Period

At the Board of Directors meeting held today, the company made a resolution regarding dividend of retained earnings with March 31, 2026 as the record date, the details of which we would like to announce as follows.

In addition, we would also like to inform you of the dividend forecast for the fiscal year ending March 2027, as stated in the "Earnings Report for the Fiscal Year Ending March 2026 [JGAAP] (Consolidated)" announced today.

1. Details of dividend

At the meeting of the Board of Directors held today, the company made a resolution to increase the dividend with the record date of March 31, 2026 by 2 yen per share in comparison with the most recent dividend forecast, setting it at 32 yen per share.

2. Background

Valuing the return to shareholders as one of the most important management priorities, we have adopted the policy of maintaining the dividend payout ratio of 50% or more, and also to implement progressive dividend, taking into consideration our business performance and future outlook, as well as making active growth investments at the same time. Considering the current and future business activities, we have decided to increase the year-end dividend by 2 yen per share in comparison with the most recent dividend forecast, resulting at 32 yen per share.
